Honours BA in Psychology Requirements: PSYC 101, 102, 204, 210, 220, 230, 255, 270, 305, 400AA, 400AB, 405; PSYC 406 or 407; one additional 400-level PSYC course; five additional 300- or 400-level PSYC courses

Arts Core Requirements: ENGL 100; 2 courses in a single language other than English; any lab course in the Natural Sciences or GEOG 121; any course in the Media, Art, and Performance (MAP); and a course in each of the following areas:

Numerical or Logical Reasoning: One course from: Any in MATH, STAT, or CS (except CS 100), PHIL 150, 352, 450, 452, 460, or SOST 201

Textual Studies: One course from: ENGL 110, RLST 245, 248, PHIL 100 or SOST 110

Cultural Difference: One course from: Any in ANTH, RLST, (except RLST 181, 184, 186, 188, 284, or 288), GEOG 100 or 120, INDG 232, 234, 238, 332, or 432.

Social and Cultural Heritage: One course from: Any in HIST, CATH 200, CLASS 100, or IDS 100, INDG 208, 210, 215, 216, 218, 219, 221, 228, 230 or INDL 241, 242, or any one of INDL 240AA-ZZ.

The Social Sciences: This requirement is met with courses taken in the major.

Indigenous Knowledge: One course from: Any in INCA, INDG, INHS, any of ENGL 214, 310AA-ZZ, GEOG 344, HIST 310, JS 350, 351, KIN 105, LING 230, PSCI 338, SOC 214, or any other course approved by the Faculty of Arts as having substantial indigenous content.

Additional Courses: 11 open electives

Note: Do not count on different sections of the same Psychology course being offered in both Fall and Winter semesters. This is especially true of 300- and 400-level courses.

Some Psychology courses may be offered in the spring or summer sessions depending on student demand and availability of instructors.
